Peniel Family Wellness Clinic is an out-patient program whose management if directly under Peniel Treatment Facility. We provide clinical therapy and Christian counseling with practical emphasis to children, teens and families.

Individual as well as family sessions are conducted by trained clinicians and overseen by a licensed social worker with years of experience and success.

Appointments are scheduled in advance based on the patient's need and at the discretion of the clinician. Group therapy is also provided according to age and diagnosis compatibility.
